They are docile, virile, sound footed and offer outcross genetics for the majority of the industry.

Feed covers up faults and a lack of high-energy feed will expose them. This low maintenance maternal cow herd that efficiently utilizes available resources is the result of a selection process that no number can measure.

These maternally bred bulls are designed to be problem free with an emphasis on balanced traits of economic value. They are virile, thick and heavily muscled. Bulls that look like bulls with masculine crests and big nuts are the rule at Ginger Hill.

Cowherd efficiency and reproductive soundness are the keys to long term sustainability and profit. Since 2014, over 96% of our cowherd has conceived in the first 60 days of breeding. No high cost feeds or protein supplements. Just grass and grass hay! Wean more calves, more pounds and more profit per cow exposed with The Ginger Hill Line.

According to Kris Ringwall, NDSU Extension, data from North Dakota beef herds between 2000-2014 reveals a 3 lb. increase in actual weaning weights. Pounds weaned per cow exposed is down 21 lbs. and costs per cow exposed is up 200%.
